Dear Congressman Waxman:

This letter provides you supplemental information to that which I have already provided in response to your 14 January letter. This new information is largely based on a detailed review of my home phone records (as I originally did my office records) as a possible source of information as to conversations with Enron employees since becoming Secretary of the Army. I do not retain those records as a matter of course, and therefore found it necessary to contact the local telephone company to ask them to send me duplicate records. I have now received and reviewed them. Based upon that review and further reflection, I am able to add to the information previously provided to you. In fact, some of the information provided below undoubtedly goes beyond your letter request, among other reasons, because I am including conversations that may have only involved my wife.

First, in addition to speaking to Messrs. Horton, Hurt, Leff and Rolfes at the Pentagon, my telephone bills show that I spoke to them from my home. In the case of Hurt and Rolfes, many of these calls may have been placed by my wife, who is a close friend of the wives of these gentlemen. Our bill also shows that either my wife or I called David Haug on November 5 and 6, but apparently did not reach him at that time.


Second, in addition to the Enron employees I identified in my last letter, I also spoke to Dominick Izzo and Geoffrey Prosch (I believe these calls concerned their joining me at the Pentagon; both have since done so), Norm Blake, John Duncan, Jack Urquhart and Joe Sutton. I also saw John Duncan at parties in Aspen, Colorado, over July 4 and Christmas 2001. Duncan, Urquhart and Blake were non-employee Directors of Enron while Sutton is an ex-employee of Enron.

The attached chart lists these additional telephone conversations to the extent they can currently be documented from my records. Of course, my phone bills only show individuals whom I may have called; I cannot document (or be certain as to) the same or different people calling me. For example, I think that some of the above people, such as David Haug, and others identified in my last letter to you, such as Ed Giblin, may also have called me at home.

While I cannot now reconstruct each of the conversations I have listed, it is fair to say that virtually all conversations I had with friends or persons related to Enron, especially after Enron's financial problems became public, would have involved some comment or discussion relating in at least a general way to Enron's financial condition. For that matter, when the Enron story became front-page news, I am relatively certain that I discussed the general topic with many people, just as most Americans have.

Finally, I emphasize again that I am absolutely certain that neither before or after becoming Secretary of the Army has anyone related to Enron (or anyone else for that matter) ever asked me to use my office to assist Enron in any way, shape or form; and since becoming Secretary of the Army I have never used my office to assist Enron. I have spent the majority of my adult life serving this country and I took this position to serve the Army and the United States. While I am here, I intend to exert all my efforts to do just that.
